1. Start Early and Plan Ahead

Living Room

- **Decor**: Pack framed pictures and mirrors in specialty boxes. Use corner protectors to avoid damage.

Kitchen

- **Dishes & Glassware**: Wrap each item individually in packing paper. Use dish boxes with dividers for added protection.
- **Appliances**: Clean and dry appliances before packing. Secure cords with tape, and pack each appliance in its original box or a well-padded alternative.
- **Pantry Items**: Use up perishable goods before moving. Seal spices and non-perishables in zip-lock bags to prevent spills.



- **Clothing**: Use wardrobe boxes for hanging clothes. Folded clothes can go in suitcases or medium-sized boxes.
- **Bedding & Linens**: Place sheets, blankets, and towels in large boxes or vacuum-seal bags to save space.
- **Jewelry & Valuables**: Pack these items separately and keep them with you during the move for security.

Bathrooms

- Toiletries: Ensure all bottles are sealed tightly. Place them in plastic bags to prevent leaks.
- Towels & Mats: Pack in a medium-sized box or use them as padding in other boxes.
- **Medicine Cabinet**: Dispose of expired medications safely. Pack essentials in a small box and keep them accessible.

4. Specialty Items

- **Artwork**: Use mirror boxes and corner protectors. Cover the surface with cardboard before wrapping it in bubble wrap.
- **Musical Instruments**: If you don't have a hard case, wrap the instrument in several layers of bubble wrap. Label the box as "fragile."
- **Plants**: If you're moving locally, water plants the day before moving and pack them in open boxes. For long-distance moves, consider giving them to a friend or donating them.

5. Labeling and Inventory

- **Labels**: Clearly label each box with the room it belongs to and a brief description of its contents. Mark boxes with fragile items.
- Inventory List: Keep a master inventory list of all boxes, noting any particularly valuable or fragile items.
